Officially named "The Women's International Cup," the cup for the Curtis Cup Match was officially presented in 1932 by Harriot and Margaret Curtis, sisters who won the U.S. Women's Amateur four times between them. The cup, a silver bowl of Paul Revere design, is inscribed "To stimulate friendly rivalry among the women golfers of many lands." The Curtis Cup was first presented in 1927 to give momentum to the proposed competition, but play didn't begin until 1932, largely because of financial reasons.

2010 Conditions of Play

The Teams

The Curtis Cup Match is played by women amateur golfers, one team from the United States of America and one team from England, Ireland, Northern Ireland, Scotland and Wales (GB&I). The teams consist of not more than eight players and a captain.

The USA Team is selected by the USGA International Team Selection Committee. The Ladies Golf Union selects the team from Great Britain and Ireland. Players must be citizens of the country they represent.

Schedule of Play

- Friday, June 11 – Three foursomes (alternate-shot) matches (18 holes); three four-ball (better-ball) matches (18 holes)
- Saturday, June 12 – Three four-ball (better-ball) matches (18 holes); three foursomes (alternate-shot) matches (18 holes)
- Sunday, June 13 – Eight singles matches (18 holes)

Scoring

Victory in a match scores one point. When a match goes 18 holes without a decision, one-half point is awarded to each side.

Miscellaneous

The Match is conducted every two years, alternately in the United States of America and Great Britain and Ireland. The country winning the Match takes custody of the trophy for the ensuing two years. In case of a tie, the trophy remains with the previous winner.

United States of America Wins 2008 Match

Stacy Lewis and Alison Walshe went undefeated to lead the squad from the United States of America to a 13-7 victory over Great Britain and Ireland at the 2008 Curtis Cup Match, which was played on the Old Course at St. Andrews in Scotland.

It was the sixth consecutive win for the Americans in the Match, which features an eight-woman amateur squad from the USA against one representing England, Scotland, Northern Ireland, Ireland and Wales. The last GB&I win came in 1996.

Lewis, a 23-year-old from The Woodlands, Texas, went 5-0 for the USA, with two foursomes (alternate-shot) and two four-ball (best-ball) victories prior to Sunday's 3-and-2 singles win over Scotland's Liz Bennett that clinched the winning point.

It is the first time any player has gone 5-0 in any single Match. This was also the first time the Curtis Cup was waged over three days, featuring foursomes and four-ball matches the first two days and all eight players from each side competing in Sunday singles.

"Coming in, I wanted to play as much as I could and win every match," said Lewis, the 2007 NCAA Division I individual women's champion. "With match play you're never really sure what's going to happen. I'm very happy that I got all the wins."

Walshe, 22, of Westford, Mass., won her fourth match with a 1-up decision over Scottish teenager Sally Watson to earn the USA's final point and put an exclamation point on the six-point victory.

Tiffany Joh of San Diego, Calif., got off to a slow start in her match against Scotland's Carly Booth, the youngest

player in the 2008 Match at age 15. Joh bogeyed the first two holes to give Booth a 2-up lead. But Joh came roaring back to win seven of the next 10 holes en route to a 6-and-5 victory for the USA's first point of the day.

Kimberly Kim of Hilo, Hawaii, added a second point with a 3-and-1 win over Breanne Loucks of Wales, the lone holdover from the GB&I's 2006 Curtis Cup Team.

"It felt great because the rest of the team didn't have to worry," said Kim, who in 2006 became the youngest U.S. Women's Amateur champion in history at 14 years old. "We got the points up fast."

At that point, the only remaining mystery was who would clinch the winning point for the Americans. For a moment it seemed three-time national collegiate player of the year Amanda Blumenherst of Scottsdale, Ariz., would do the honors against England's Jodi Ewart. But Lewis beat her to the punch when she closed out Bennett on the 16th green.

Blumenherst's match against Ewart concluded moments later with a 2-and-1 win, giving her a total of 3½ points for the Match.

USA Captain Carol Semple Thompson, who played in a record 12 Curtis Cup Matches, was impressed by her team's effort in the singles matches on a day that featured plenty of rain, wind and chilly temperatures.

"I have a very strong team but I didn't think they would play as well as they did today in the worst weather of the three days," said Thompson, a seven-time USGA champion. "All credit to my players. They did a great job. They just stayed in there and finished strongly."

The USA now holds a 26-6-3 all-time record in the Match.

2008 Match Notes

Weather

Friday was chilly, with rain in the morning. Sunny with light wind Saturday. Rainy and cold with strong winds Sunday.

Notes

The victory was the sixth consecutive win for the USA Team ... Stacy Lewis clinched the winning point for the USA with her singles victory Sunday afternoon, but none of her teammates were there to see it. They were all one hole ahead, watching Amanda Blumenherst's match. Lewis wound up earning the winning point about a minute before Blumenherst earned her victory ... Lewis turned pro the week after the Curtis Cup. She then qualified for the U.S. Women's Open, which was her first professional event, where she was the leader after three rounds before finishing tied for third ... The USA Team featured four USGA champions – Meghan Bolger (2006, 2007 Women's Mid-Amateur); Mina Harigae (2007 Women's Amateur Public Links); Kimberly Kim (2006 Women's Amateur); and Tiffany Joh (2006 Women's

Amateur Public Links) ... Their captain, Carol Semple Thompson, is a seven-time USGA champion who played in 12 Curtis Cup Matches, more than anyone in history ... Her GB&I counterpart, Mary McKenna, played in a record nine Matches for the Great Britain and Ireland side ... At 15, Carly Booth was the youngest player in history for the GB&I ... Although Bolger was the only player on the American side not to earn a point for the USA, she still had a memorable week. Her 30th birthday was Friday of the Match, and she got engaged on the Swilken Bridge on the 18th hole Sunday evening after the Match concluded ... Harigae kicked her putter during her four-ball match with Kim Saturday afternoon and needed to putt with her rescue club and sand wedge for the rest of the match. Despite that, she and Kim won their match ... Alison Walshe, who was born in Ireland but moved to the U.S. at age 4, was of great interest to the UK media due to her Irish heritage ... Scottish teenagers Sally Watson and Krystle Caithness, who both live about 20 minutes from the Old Course, led the GB&I with three points apiece ... Large crowds were on hand to watch the Match each day, with a peak of 8,500 spectators on Saturday.

Match History

Officially named “The Women’s International Cup,” the cup for the Curtis Cup Match was officially presented in 1932 by Harriot and Margaret Curtis, sisters who won the U.S. Women’s Amateur four times between them. The cup, a silver bowl of Paul Revere design, is inscribed “To stimulate friendly rivalry among the women golfers of many lands.” The cup was first presented in 1927 to give momentum to the proposed competition, but play didn’t begin until 1932, largely because of financial reasons.

As beloved as the Curtis Cup Match is among those who have battled for it, no other USGA competition has had such problems getting off the ground.

The Match has its origins in an informal match played in 1905. Frances Griscom of Philadelphia, the 1900 U.S. Women’s Amateur champion, suggested that it would be fun for a group to play in the British Ladies Open Amateur, at Cromer, England. Eight Americans made the trip to play, including Griscom, Georgianna Bishop, the 1904 Women’s Amateur champion, and Harriot and Margaret Curtis.

An informal match developed between the Americans and a team from Britain. Although the USA was soundly beaten, the exhilaration and goodwill established by their visit always stayed with the competitors, particularly with Margaret and Harriot Curtis.

Interest in an international match was revived at a 1924 meeting of the Women’s Eastern Golf Association and became a subject of discussion among the Association, the British Ladies’ Golf Union and the French Golf Union over the next five years. In 1927, the Curtis sisters gave the idea another push by donating a cup for an international match. Fanny Osgood of Boston was appointed to again take up the matter with the LGU.

A match was tentatively planned for 1928, but financial obstacles made it impossible.

In 1928, the USGA Women’s Committee appointed a subcommittee to consider an international match, but

the idea was stymied by the usual lack of funding. In 1930, the great American amateur Glenna Collett Vare took matters into her own hands and arranged for a group of her countrywomen to play in Great Britain.

In 1931, the LGU agreed to regular matches with the United States. The USGA then decided to finance the American Team and administer the competition. The Curtis Cup was accepted that same year as the official trophy.

The series began the following year with the United States opposing Great Britain, with a proviso that France might join in whenever it was able to do so. While it was hoped that many nations would eventually join in the Match, the Curtis Cup has remained a two-sided competition.

The first Curtis Cup Match was played in 1932 at Wentworth Golf Club in England. Marion Hollins captained the American Team, which consisted of

Vare, Maureen Orcutt, Virginia Van Wie, Opal Hill, Helen Hicks, Leona Pressler Cheney and Dorothy Higbie. The team representing Great Britain and Ireland was made up of Joyce Wethered, the famous English champion who also served as captain, Wanda Morgan, Enid Wilson, Molly Gourlay, Doris Park, Diana Fishwick, Elsie Corlett and Mrs. J.B. Watson. The Americans prevailed, 5½ to 3½.

Although the Americans dominated until recent years, the true meaning of the Curtis Cup Match has never been overshadowed by the results and the Match has always been regarded as a vehicle of international friendship and understanding.

The 2008 Match at St. Andrews marked a change in format. The Match changed to a three-day format, featuring three foursomes and three four-ball (better-ball) matches on the first two days. On the final day, there are eight singles matches, meaning all eight players from each side competed in singles.

The flag-raising ceremony at the Curtis Cup Match is one of the most emotionally stirring moments in amateur golf.

Noreen Mohler — 2010 USA Curtis Cup Captain

Noreen Mohler, 56, of Bethlehem, Pa., was named the captain of the USA Team for the 2010 Curtis Cup in February 2009. Mohler was a member of the USA’s victorious 1978 Curtis Cup Team that defeated Great Britain and Ireland by a 12-6 margin at The Apawamis Club in Rye, N.Y.

“This is the highest honor that I have ever received in my golfing career,” said Mohler. “I am honored, humbled and excited about this opportunity. It was the thrill of a lifetime to play in the Curtis Cup, and I’m sure that it will be a life-changing experience as a captain.”

Mohler was a semifinalist in the 1975 U.S. Women’s Amateur Championship and has played in five U.S. Women’s Opens. After stepping away from her playing career for a number of years to concentrate on her family and business affairs, she returned to the game in 2006 and reached the quarterfinals of the 2007 USGA Senior Women’s Amateur and the semifinals of the 2008 U.S. Women’s Mid-Amateur. In 2009 she played in three USGA championships, including the U.S. Women’s Amateur, where she was the oldest player in the field. She advanced to the quarterfinals of the USGA Senior Women’s Amateur and the third round of the U.S. Women’s Mid-Amateur.

Born in Woburn, Mass., Mohler is a three-time Massachusetts State Women’s Amateur Champion (1973, 1980, 1981). She claimed the Pennsylvania Senior Women’s Amateur in 2008. She graduated from the University of New Hampshire in 1975 and owns the Marblehead Grille and Chowder House in Easton, Pa., with her husband Jeffrey.
