Officially named "The Women's International Cup," the cup for the Curtis Cup Match was officially presented in 1932 by Harriot and Margaret Curtis, sisters who won the U.S. Women's Amateur four times between them. The cup, a silver bowl of Paul Revere design, is inscribed "To stimulate friendly rivalry among the women golfers of many lands." The Curtis Cup was first presented in 1927 to give momentum to the proposed competition, but play didn't begin until 1932, largely because of financial reasons.

2014 Conditions of Play

The Teams

The Curtis Cup Match is played by women amateur golfers, one team from the United States of America and one team from England, Ireland, Northern Ireland, Scotland and Wales (GB&I). The teams consist of not more than eight players and a captain.

The USA Team is selected by the USGA International Team Selection Committee. The Ladies Golf Union selects the team from Great Britain and Ireland. Players must be citizens of the country they represent.

Schedule of Play

- Friday, June 6 — three foursomes (alternate-shot, 18 holes) and three four-ball (best-ball, 18 holes) matches
- Saturday, June 7 — three foursomes (alternate-shot, 18 holes) and three four-ball (best-ball, 18 holes) matches
- Sunday, June 8 — eight singles matches (18 holes)

Scoring

Victory in a match scores one point. When a match is all square after 18 holes, one-half point is awarded to each side.

Miscellaneous

The Match is conducted every two years, alternately in the United States of America and Great Britain and Ireland. The country winning the Match takes custody of the trophy for the ensuing two years. In case of a tie, the trophy remains with the previous winner.

Great Britain and Ireland Wins 2012 Match

Great Britain and Ireland captured five singles matches on Sunday to take a 10.5 to 9.5 victory at the 2012 Curtis Cup Match, conducted at The Nairn Golf Club in Nairn, Scotland. It was GB&I's first title since 1996 and only its seventh in Match history.

"I'm exceptionally proud of the team. They're the ones who pulled it through," said GB&I Captain Tegwen Matthews, the first victorious GB&I captain since Ita Butler in 1996.

"It was certainly not the result I was looking for," said USA Captain Pat Cornett. "So I am a little disappointed, but then the result is good for the game and good for the Curtis Cup."

The winning point came courtesy of Northern Ireland's Stephanie Meadow, 20, who defeated Amy Anderson, 19, of Oxbow, N.D., by a 4-and-2 margin.

Meadow, a member of the University of Alabama's golf team, twice built a 2-up lead over Anderson, the 2009 U.S. Girls' Junior champion. But Anderson cut the deficit with a clutch 2-foot birdie at the par-4 12th.

"At that point, I thought things were going to turn our way," said Anderson. "I hit a great drive at 13, but I got a funky lie. Somehow I hit the 5-wood fat, and it just sprayed off to the right in about the worst spot you could be."

Anderson ended up in a pot bunker just short of the green, and conceded the hole, falling to 2 down. Meadow's birdie at the par-3 15th put the victory within her grasp, and Anderson's wayward tee shot at the 16th ultimately gave the trophy to GB&I.

"I knew all along that it would come down to my match," said Meadow, who has five career victories for the Crimson Tide. "I was watching the boards. I knew how the first four matches had gone so I knew what I had to do."

"I think I'll be replaying every hole every night for quite some time," said a disappointed Anderson.

GB&I captured the opening three singles matches, including come-from-behind victories from Kelly Tidy, 20, of England, and Amy Boulden, 19, of Wales.

The morning had started strong for the Americans, with Austin Ernst, 20, of Seneca, S.C., and Emily Tubert, 20, of Burbank, Calif., building 2-up leads by the fifth hole over Tidy and Boulden, respectively.

"I wanted to set the pace and at the beginning of the match I was pretty much doing that," said Ernst, who extended her lead over Tidy to 3 up through six. "I played flawless golf pretty much for the first six holes."

But the tide quickly turned in favor of GB&I. Tidy knocked in a 25-foot birdie at the par-5 seventh to tighten the gap, and both players squared their matches with consecutive birdies at the ninth and 10th. Ernst and Tubert were never able to gain any advantage and fell by 2-and-1 and 3-and-1 margins, respectively.

"That [birdie] just got me going," said Tidy, who finished with a 2-2 record. "It got me fired up and it let me know I could beat her. It's just that one little putt that can get a roll going."

"It looked like there was a lot of red and all square [on the leader board]," said Tubert, the 2010 U.S. Women's Amateur Public Links champion. "And then all of a sudden I looked up and it was a different story."

Lisa McCloskey, 20, of Houston, Texas, cruised to a 4-and-3 win over Pamela Pretswell, 23, of Scotland, and temporarily stopped the GB&I roll. But Holly Clyburn, 20, of England, tallied GB&I's third point with a 3-and-2 victory over Erica Popson, 21, of Davenport, Fla.

McCloskey's victory came as redemption following losses on Friday afternoon and Saturday morning.

"I guess I was a little bit riled up and wanted to show them that I could get one point on the board," said McCloskey, the 2010 U.S. Women's Amateur Public Links runner-up.

The USA's other two victories came from 2010 veteran Tiffany Lua, who edged Bronte Law, 2 up, and Brooke Pancake, whose final amateur competition ended with a resounding 6-and-5 triumph over Ireland's Leona Maguire.

England's Charley Hull won her only point in the Match, taking a 5-and-3 victory over Lindy Duncan, 21, of Fort Lauderdale, Fla.

2012 Match Notes

Weather

Temperatures were in the mid-50s all three days, but noticeably cooled with a wind chill. Extremely windy on Friday, while Saturday morning saw intermittent rain showers.

Notes

The GB&I victory was the first since the 1996 Match at Killarney G. & F.C. in Ireland ... The USA Team included two past USGA champions — Amy Anderson (2009 Girls' Junior) and Emily Tubert (2010 Women's Amateur Public Links). Lisa McCloskey, another member of the USA Team, was the runner-up to Tubert at the 2010 WAPL ... For the first time, the USA Team consisted of all collegiate players ... Three members of the GB&I Team competed in 2010 — Holly Clyburn, Leona Maguire and Pamela Pretswell ... Tiffany Lua was the lone returner from the 2010 USA Team, and the only member of that team yet to turn professional ... One week prior to the Match, Brooke Pancake holed a 4-foot birdie putt to win the University of Alabama's NCAA Division I Women's Golf Championship. She also finished second in the individual

competition. The 2012 Curtis Cup Match marked the end of Pancake's amateur career, as she turned professional immediately following the Match ... Pancake and Stephanie Meadow of GB&I were college teammates at the University of Alabama, but never faced each other in at the Curtis Cup ... On the first day of the Match, Pancake and Anderson were named Capital One Academic All-Americans, and Pancake was named Academic All-American of the Year. Tubert received third-team honors ... Family members from all eight USA players traveled to Nairn, as did several of their college and personal coaches ... USA Captain Pat Cornett sustained a broken right ankle following the tee shots of the final group Friday afternoon. Past player and captain Carol Semple Thompson, in attendance as a USA supporter, assumed interim captain duties while Cornett was hospitalized for treatment. Cornett resumed her captaincy on Saturday ... The Olympic torch passed through Nairn on Sunday as part of the official Olympic Torch Relay prior to the 2012 Games conducted in London, England. The players on both sides posed for pictures with the torch prior to teeing off ... The players from both teams participated in a party in the town of Nairn celebrating Queen Elizabeth's Diamond Jubilee on the Tuesday of Match week.

Match History

Officially named “The Women’s International Cup,” the cup for the Curtis Cup Match was officially presented in 1932 by Harriot and Margaret Curtis, sisters who won the U.S. Women’s Amateur four times between them. The cup, a silver bowl of Paul Revere design, is inscribed “To stimulate friendly rivalry among the women golfers of many lands.” The cup was first presented in 1927 to give momentum to the proposed competition, but play didn’t begin until 1932, largely due to financial reasons.

As beloved as the Curtis Cup Match is among those who have battled for it, no other USGA competition has had such problems getting off the ground.

The Match has its origins in an informal match played in 1905. Frances Griscom of Philadelphia, the 1900 U.S. Women’s Amateur champion, suggested that it would be fun for a group to play in the British Ladies Open Amateur, at Cromer, England. Eight Americans made the trip to play, including Griscom, Georgianna Bishop, the 1904 Women’s Amateur champion, and Harriot and Margaret Curtis.

An informal match developed between the Americans and a team from Britain. Although the USA was soundly beaten, the exhilaration and goodwill established by their visit always stayed with the competitors, particularly with Margaret and Harriot Curtis.

Interest in an international match was revived at a 1924 meeting of the Women’s Eastern Golf Association and became a subject of discussion among the Association, the British Ladies’ Golf Union and the French Golf Union over the next five years. In 1927, the Curtis sisters gave the idea another push by donating a cup for an international match. Fanny Osgood of Boston was appointed to again take up the matter with the LGU.

A match was tentatively planned for 1928, but financial obstacles made it impossible.

In 1928, the USGA Women’s Committee appointed a sub-committee to consider an international match, but the idea was stymied by the usual lack of funding. In 1930, the great American amateur Glenna Collett Vare took matters into her own hands and arranged for a group of her countrywomen to play in Great Britain.

In 1931, the LGU agreed to regular matches with the United States. The USGA then decided to finance the American Team and administer the competition. The Curtis Cup was accepted that same year as the official trophy.

The series began the following year with the United States opposing Great Britain, with a proviso that France might join in whenever it was able to do so. While it was hoped that many nations would eventually join in the Match, the Curtis Cup has remained a two-sided competition.

The first Curtis Cup Match was played in 1932 at Wentworth Golf Club in England. Marion Hollins captained the American Team, which consisted of Vare, Maureen Orcutt, Virginia Van Wie, Opal Hill, Helen Hicks, Leona Pressler Cheney and Dorothy Higbie. The team representing Great Britain and Ireland was made up of Joyce Wethered, the famous English champion who also served as captain, Wanda Morgan, Enid Wilson, Molly Gourlay, Doris Park, Diana Fishwick, Elsie Corlett and Mrs. J.B. Watson. The Americans prevailed, 5½ to 3½.

The 2008 Match at St. Andrews marked a change in format. The Match changed to a three-day format, featuring three foursomes and three four-ball (better-ball) matches on the first two days. On the final day, there are eight singles matches, meaning all eight players from each side compete in singles.

The true meaning of the Curtis Cup Match has never been overshadowed by the results and the Match has always been regarded as a vehicle of international friendship and understanding.

Ellen Port, 2014 USA Curtis Cup Captain

Six-time USGA champion Ellen Port, of St. Louis, Mo., will serve as captain of the 2014 USA Curtis Cup Team.

“Ellen is one of the great USGA amateur champions of the modern era,” said Dot Paluck, chairman of the USGA Women’s Committee. “She has well represented the United States in past Curtis Cup Matches, and we are proud to have her as captain of the 2014 Team.”

“It’s an honor and privilege to serve the USGA, my future players and the game that I’ve grown to love as the captain of the 2014 USA Curtis Cup Team,” said Port, a member of the 1994 and 1996 USA Curtis Cup Teams. “It’s an added bonus to have the venue in my hometown, at a club that is so rich in golf history and tradition.”

Port won the 1995, 1996, 2000 and 2011 U.S. Women’s Mid-Amateurs and the 2012 and 2013 U.S. Senior Women’s Amateurs and is only the sixth woman to win six USGA championship titles, joining JoAnne Gunderson Carner (eight victories), Carol Semple Thompson (seven), Anne Quast Sander (seven,) Glenna Collett Vare (six) and Hollis Stacy (six). She is one of two women to win both the Women’s Mid-Amateur and the Senior Women’s Amateur, joining renowned career amateur and two-time USA Curtis Cup Captain Semple Thompson, and the 11-year span between her third and fourth Women’s Mid-Amateur victories is a championship record. She was runner-up at the 2002 Women’s Mid-Amateur, and is a record four-time Women’s Mid-Amateur stroke-play medalist (2000, 2001, 2002, 2010). Port has 58 Women’s Mid-Amateur match victories, the most in championship history, and has also competed in the U.S. Women’s Open, U.S. Women’s Amateur, U.S. Women’s Amateur Public Links and USGA Women’s State Team championships.

In addition to her USGA titles, Port is an eight-time Missouri Women’s Amateur champion, most recently in 2012, the most in championship history. She is a 12-time St. Louis Metropolitan champion, most recently in 2010, and was inducted into the Missouri Sports Hall of Fame and the St. Louis Sports Hall of Fame in 2012. Port also won the 1994 Women’s TRANS National Golf Association Amateur Championship.

Port began playing golf at age 24 and is a 1983 graduate of the University of Missouri. Since 1986, she has served on the staff of the John Burroughs School in St. Louis, where she teaches physical education and coaches the boys and girls golf teams. She is married to Andy Port and has two teenage children, Drew and Katie.
