2015 Conditions of Play

The Teams

The Walker Cup Match is played by male amateur golfers, one team from the United States of America and one team from England, Ireland, Northern Ireland, Scotland and Wales (GB&I). The teams consist of not more than 10 players and a captain.

The USA Team is selected by the United States Golf Association, and the GB&I Team by The R&A.

Schedule of Play

- Saturday, Sept. 12 — Four foursomes matches (18 holes); eight singles matches (18 holes)
- Sunday, Sept. 13 — Four foursomes matches (18 holes); 10 singles matches (18 holes)

Scoring

Victory in a match scores one point. When a match goes 18 holes without a decision, one-half point is awarded to each side.

Miscellaneous

The Match is held every two years, alternately in the United States of America and Great Britain and Ireland. The country winning the Match takes custody of the Walker Cup for the ensuing two years. In case of a tie, the cup stays with the previous winner until the next Match is played.

United States of America Wins the 2013 Match

The United States of America dominated singles play on both days and defeated Great Britain and Ireland, 17–9, to win the 44th Walker Cup Match at the 6,995–yard, par–72 National Golf Links of America in Southampton, N.Y., the site of the inaugural Match in 1922.

“It’s something I have been wanting for a long, long time, particularly after we lost in 2011,” said USA Captain Jim Holtgrieve of winning the Cup. “I was hoping I would get a mulligan for ‘13 and when I knew it was going to be at National Golf Links, which is where it all started, I wanted so bad to come here. Yes. I wanted to win but I wanted to do something good for golf and this, to me, was truly good for golf.”

In winning seven of the 10 afternoon singles matches Sunday, the USA captured 13½ of the possible 18 points in the singles sessions over two days. The host team has won four of the last five Matches and has not been defeated on home soil since the USA lost in 2001.

Nathan Smith, 35, playing in his third Match, clinched the 14th point and the Match for the USA with a 4–and–3 decision over Nathan Kimsey. He is one of two mid–amateur players (25 years and older) on the USA Team and has won four U.S. Mid–Amateur Championships and played in four Masters Tournaments.

“This ranks at the top of the list,” said Smith of winning the clinching point. “I never wanted a point so much in my life. This (Match) means the most. I’m happy for Jim (Holtgrieve). Nobody deserves it more than him and loves the game of golf and put more hard work into a team than him.”

Before Smith clinched the Cup victory, the other mid–amateur, 45–year–old high school teacher Todd White, won his match over Rhys Pugh, GB&I’s star in their 2011 victory in Scotland, for the team’s 13th point.

Bobby Wyatt, one of three USA Team members from the University of Alabama’s NCAA Division I championship squad, won his foursomes and singles matches on Sunday and was undefeated for the Match. He was the team’s top point–getter with 3½.

Also recording an undefeated mark for the USA was Michael Kim of the University of California–Berkeley, who was the low amateur at the 2013 U.S. Open Championship. Kim was 3–0 with two singles wins and one foursomes victory.

Wyatt and Alabama teammate Justin Thomas won the first two matches of the Sunday singles session handily as the USA captured four of the first five matches.

“They all focused together,” Holtgrieve said. “They all played together. They all worked together and they helped each other with their games. There were no individuals. It was a team.”

“They adapted to conditions a little bit better – the greens changed and there were very, very severe pin positions,” GB&I captain Nigel Edwards said of the USA. “They holed out a little bit better and I would say the short shots into the green, the distance control, that’s where they outdid us. When they did hit it over the back they got up and down and we didn’t.”

The morning foursomes (alternate–shot) matches were split at 2–2 for a 10–6 USA lead entering the afternoon singles and the Americans needing just 3½ more points to clinch victory.

University of Alabama teammates Wyatt and Cory Whitsett snagged one of the morning foursomes points with a 2–and–1 win over Kimsey and Max Orrin.

The other USA foursomes win was by Max Homa and Kim, who edged Pugh and Garrick Porteus, 1 up.

The GB&I wins came from the teams of 2013 U.S. Amateur champion Matt Fitzpatrick and U.S. Amateur co–medalist Neil Raymond, and Gavin Moynihan and Kevin Phelan.

Fitzpatrick and Raymond topped Michael Weaver and White, 3 and 2. Moynihan and Phelan beat Patrick Rodgers and Jordan Niebrugge, 2 up, recovering from a 4–down deficit with 11 holes to play.

Fitzpatrick finished as the top scorer for GB&I with a 3–1 record.

The USA is a perfect 6–0 in Matches held in the state of New York and holds a 35–8–1 lead in the series.

Todd White, 45, of the USA, was the oldest participant ... Gavin Moynihan of GB&I was the youngest at age 18 ... The USA Team is undefeated (6–0) in Matches held in the state of New York ... George Bush, the 43rd president of the USA, spoke at the opening ceremonies and played four holes with the USA Team during Thursday's practice ... Former USGA president and two-time USGA champion Bill Campbell, who passed away the week before at age 90, was honored at the opening ceremony ... Three members of the University of Alabama team that won the 2013 NCAA Men's Division I title represented the USA: Justin Thomas, Cory Whitsett and Bobby Wyatt. Incoming Alabama freshman Gavin Moynihan was on the GB&I Team ... Three members of the University of California–Berkeley team were on the USA Team: Max Homa, Michael Kim and Michael Weaver ... The 2013 Match was the second USGA competition at The National Golf Links of America. The first was the inaugural Match in 1922 ... Homa scored what is believed to be the first a hole-in-one in Walker Cup history on the par-3 sixth hole during his Sunday singles match against Kevin Phelan.

Match History

The Walker Cup Match began in the wake of World War I with a view toward stimulating golf interest on both sides of the Atlantic. The match grew in part out of two international matches between the USA and Canada, in 1919 and 1920.

At the same time, British and American amateurs considered each nation's national amateur championship a great plum. Meanwhile, the USGA Executive Committee had been invited to Great Britain for a series of meetings with the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews Rules Committee. The meeting was to look at the advisability of modifying various rules of the game. Among the participants was George Herbert Walker, USGA president in 1920.

Upon the Executive Committee's return to the United States of America, international team matches were discussed. The idea so appealed to Walker that he soon presented a plan and offered to donate a trophy. Walker had been a low handicap player and was a keen advocate of the game. When the press dubbed the trophy the Walker Cup, the name stuck.

In 1921, the USGA invited all golfing nations to send teams to compete in the Match, but no country was able to accept that year. The Americans stuck to their mission, however, and William C. Fownes, the 1910 U.S. Amateur champion, who had twice assembled the amateur teams that played against Canada, rounded up a third team in the spring of 1921 and took it to England. At Hoylake, the American team defeated a British team, 9-3, in an informal match the day before the British Amateur.

Early in 1922, The R&A announced that it would send a team to compete for the Walker Cup at the National Golf Links of America, Walker's home club, in Southampton, N.Y.

Originally, the competition was open to any country that might care to challenge. The USGA invited all countries to compete. Except for Great Britain, however, no other country was able to accept.

Fownes was the American captain for the inaugural match and his team consisted of Charles Evans Jr., Robert Gardner, U.S. Amateur champion Jesse Guilford, Robert T. Jones Jr., Max Marston, Francis Ouimet, Jess Sweetser and Rudolph Knepper, who did not play.

Robert Harris was captain of the British side, and his players were Cyril Tolley, Roger Wethered, Colin Aylmer, C.V.L. Hooman, W.B. Torrance, John Caven and W. Willis Mackenzie. Ernest Holderness, the British Amateur champion, was unable to make the trip.

Bernard Darwin, the golf writer of *The Times* of London, had accompanied the team and wound up playing in the Match. When Harris fell ill, Darwin was invited to compete in his place and serve as playing captain. He defeated Fownes, 3 and 1. The American Team, however, prevailed, winning the first Walker Cup Match, 8-4.

Until recent years, the USA clearly dominated the series, but the number of American victories never clouded the true purpose of the Walker Cup Match. A much higher value has been placed upon the series as a medium of international friendship and understanding between The R&A and the USGA.

The Match was played on an annual basis until 1924, when it was decided that the financial strain of annual encounters was too severe. It was also believed that interest might drop if the Matches were played too frequently. A decision was made to meet in alternate years.

The series was interrupted by World War II after the 1938 Match at St. Andrews, Scotland. When the Match resumed, in 1947, St. Andrews was again selected as the site. Under normal peacetime conditions, the Match would have been played in the USA, but postwar economic conditions would have made the trip difficult for the British.

The USA leads the series, 35-8-1.

John “Spider” Miller, 2015 USA Walker Cup Captain

The United States Golf Association has named John “Spider” Miller, of Bloomington, Ind., as the captain of the USA Team for the 2015 Walker Cup Match at Royal Lytham and St. Anne’s Golf Club in Lancashire, England.

Miller is a two-time U.S. Mid-Amateur champion, winning in 1996 and 1998, and a member of the 1999 USA Walker Cup Team.

“I’m very excited about it,” said Miller. “I am extremely thrilled and honored. It’s one of the goals that amateurs aspire to and I’m very fortunate to have been selected to follow Jim Holtgrieve. I will be reaching out to former captains, all of whom are my friends, to help me prepare.”

“Spider Miller has the experience as a competitive amateur at the highest level as well as all the requirements necessary to provide superb leadership for the USA Walker Cup Team in 2015,” said USGA vice president and Championship Committee chairman Thomas J. O’Toole Jr. “Tapped as guardian of one of golf’s greatest traditions, Spider’s patriotism, competitive spirit, camaraderie and passion for the game will help make the 2015 competition exceptional and memorable,” O’Toole added.

Miller defeated Randy Lewis, 3 and 2, to capture the 1996 U.S. Mid-Amateur title at Hartford Golf Club, in West Hartford, Conn. In 1998, he became the oldest Mid-Amateur champion at the time, by winning at age 48. Miller posted a 1-up victory over Chip Holcombe in the final at NCR Country Club’s South Course, in Kettering, Ohio.

Miller, who played in two Masters Tournaments as a result of his Mid-Amateur victories, represented the United States at the 1999 Walker Cup Match, played at Nairn Golf Club in Scotland. He teamed with Hunter Haas to win a pair of foursomes matches before losing to Paul Casey, 3 and 2, in singles. Miller also led Indiana to a tie for third at the 1997 USGA Men’s State Team Championship by carding a 54-hole score of 209 (four under par).

A native of Bloomington, Ind., Miller was inducted into the Indiana Golf Association (IGA) Hall of Fame in 2000. He twice was chosen IGA Player of the Year and is a two-time IGA Mid-Amateur champion. He and partner Jerry Nelson claimed five IGA Four-Ball championships and he was the low amateur at the Indiana State Open three times.

Miller also won the 1999 Crump Cup at Pine Valley Golf Club and has won the Gasparilla Invitational and Tri-State Championship twice each.

A 1973 graduate of Indiana University, Miller owns Best Beers, Inc. He and his wife, Kathy, have four children.

Nigel Edwards, 2015 GB&I Walker Cup Captain

Nigel Edwards has been reappointed as the captain of the Great Britain and Ireland Walker Cup Team that will face the United States of America at Royal Lytham & St Annes Golf Club in the 2015 match.

Edwards will also captain the GB&I Team as they take on the Continent of Europe in the St Andrews Trophy match at Barseback in Sweden on Aug. 29–30, 2014.

Edwards, originally from Caerphilly, Wales, will serve as Walker cup Captain for the third time in succession as the GB&I Team tries to win back the trophy in England next year. He is the first person in the modern era to be invited to captain the GB&I Team three times.

He will also serve as captain of the St Andrews Trophy team for the third time in the biennial match as GB&I look to reclaim the trophy after the Continent of Europe's narrow 12½ – 11½ victory at Portmarnock in 2012.

A long-time member of Whitchurch Golf Club in Cardiff, Edwards played in four successive Walker Cup Matches between 2001 and 2007. He was instrumental in GB&I's 2003 victory at Ganton Golf Club, holing the winning putt, finishing undefeated and as the match's leading points-scorer.

After twice playing on the winning side, Edwards completed a hat trick of wins by captaining GB&I to victory in the 2011 Match at Royal Aberdeen. Defeated by the USA side in the 2013 Match at the National Golf Links of America in Southampton, N.Y., the GB&I Team will look to reclaim the Walker Cup on home soil in 2015.

"I'm very proud to have the opportunity to captain the Great Britain and Ireland Walker Cup Team for a third time in 2015," said Edwards. "It will also be a privilege to lead the St Andrews Trophy team for a third time this year. Both events have long histories and we will be aiming to win back the trophies. I am looking forward to continuing my involvement and using my past experience as both a player and captain to make sure the players are prepared to play to the best of their ability."

In addition to his Walker Cup successes, Edwards has been part of three victorious GB&I Teams in the St Andrews Trophy, featuring in the winning 2002, 2004 and 2006 teams at Lausanne in Switzerland, Nairn in Scotland and Marianske Lazne in the Czech Republic respectively. He captained the teams which lost to the Continent of Europe at Castelconturbia in Italy in 2010 and Portmarnock in 2012.

Edwards was also part of two winning European teams in the Bonallock Trophy match against the Asia-Pacific.

"Nigel has demonstrated great passion and pride for the Walker Cup and the St Andrews Trophy and we are very pleased that he has accepted the invitation to lead the GB&I teams both this year and next," said Jonathan Plaxton, chairman of The R&A Selection Committee.

"He has proven to be very popular with the players and his experience in the amateur game will continue to be a tremendous asset as he prepares teams for the St Andrews Trophy and the Walker Cup."

Edwards is currently performance director for England Golf, and previously served as director of player development and coaching at The Golf Union of Wales.
