Green Speeds	Today's green speeds will average 11–11.5 feet in the morning, and 11.5 –12 feet in the afternoon as measured with the USGA Stimpmeter
Weather Forecast (from Jake Swick of ThorGuard):	A few high level clouds will drift off to our east around and shortly after sunrise this morning, but overall this morning should just feature lots of sunshine for us. Skies will be sunny to mostly sunny this afternoon as we see a few fair weather clouds develop over the Olympic Range across the Sound, with even a shower possible over there. After a cooler start this morning, temps will warm up into the mid-70s this afternoon. High clouds approaching from the southwest will move in our direction late today into tonight, keeping temps up a couple of degrees. Sunday will feature a mixture of high clouds and sunshine in the morning hours, with mostly sunny skies anticipated in the afternoon, when highs hit the upper 70s. Lower level clouds will push into Puget Sound Sunday night as onshore flow returns. So look for a mostly cloudy start Monday morning with partly sunny skies by lunchtime and mostly sunny skies Monday afternoon. It will be cooler, though, on Monday with highs back in the lower 70s.
