



## SATURDAY, JULY 11, 2015 – 5 AM WEATHER FORECAST

A weak storm system is passing by to the south of the area this morning, producing clouds and some sprinkles not far to our south toward the Maryland border. The system will move away to the southeast, allowing for skies to brighten this morning. The weather for the majority of today will become mostly sunny with comfortable humidity and light northeast breezes, lessening some later in the day. A clear, calm night is expected tonight, then Sunday will be sunny for the most part, with fair weather clouds mixing in during the afternoon. Temperatures and humidity will climb just a bit, with a light southerly breeze at times Sunday afternoon. Monday will see a gradual increase in clouds and humidity with a chance for a shower or storm late.
