
# U.S. Women's Open Championship 2016

SUNG HYUN PARK: I feel that there are a lot of parts where I came a little short and I just want to get back going further.

Q. Was it disappointing in the putting today? SUNG HYUN PARK: Yes, that's what I'm saying.

### Q. What was the hardest? Was it the putting? Was it the conditions today?

SUNG HYUN PARK: I am disappointed by the putting, but the difficult environment was the wind going on today.

#### Q. You seem to be a very focused player. Is it just good concentration?

SUNG HYUN PARK: I am always focused and today I felt even more focused.

#### Q. Does any golf course in Korea compare to this golf course at all?

SUNG HYUN PARK: There are some courses that are similar, but then the fairways are pretty hard to some of the courses in Korea.

#### Q. How hard is it to focus right now, knowing that you are that close to the lead?

SUNG HYUN PARK: I have done my best today. There's still one more round going on, and it's great that I had this experience to come out here to the U.S. Open.

# Q. Does it make you feel more comfortable playing with older competitors from Korea or does it make you more nervous playing with some of these people?

SUNG HYUN PARK: A lot of the Korean golfers, especially those that are older, have made it a comfortable environment for me to play in.

#### Q. So you would prefer to play with them tomorrow?

SUNG HYUN PARK: Yeah.

#### Q. No nerves?

SUNG HYUN PARK: I felt comfortable and I wasn't as



nervous as I thought I would be.
