Alternate Arrival Locations

If you are planning to arrive at any airport other than COS, you will be responsible for your own transportation to The Broadmoor where you will be issued your courtesy car.

Lexus SUV Courtesy Car Distribution

Each player will be provided with a Lexus courtesy car for use during the week of the 2018 U.S. Senior Open. Pertinent directions and procedures will be found within the vehicle as well as a built-in navigation system for your convenience.

Upon your arrival into COS, a transportation representative will be located near the information desk in baggage claim.

- For players staying at The Broadmoor, the representative will escort you to a courtesy vehicle for transfer to The Broadmoor, where your courtesy car will be available. Players will receive their keys upon check-in.
- For players making their own accommodation arrangements, your courtesy car will be available for pick up upon arrival into COS or the Colorado Jet Center.

PLAYER INFORMATION

Credentials

Credentials will be distributed at Player Registration beginning Sunday, June 24 (see “Registration”). Each player will receive a credential for himself and may request a maximum of twelve (12) complimentary credentials for family and/or guests. Of that quantity, a player may request all of the following:

- **Four (4) “Player Guest” credentials** for guests (including a spouse) which allow week-long access into Player Hospitality located in the Broadmoor Golf Club. Player Hospitality is only for players, their spouses and guests who have “Player Guest” credentials. “Player Guest” credentials do not allow inside-the-ropes access. Due to space limitations, players will be strictly limited to a maximum of four (4) “Player Guest” credentials.
- **Two (2) complimentary Centennial Club ticket packages** which will allow week-long access to the championship grounds and the Centennial Club; an exclusive climate controlled tent located between the 1st and 3rd fairways featuring comfortable seating and live television coverage of the U.S. Senior Open. Food and beverage is available for an additional charge.
- **Four (4) complimentary Gallery ticket packages** which will allow week-long access to the championship grounds.

In addition to the complimentary credentials above, each player may request up to two (2) complimentary credentials for their designated instructors. The “Player Instructor” credential will provide access to the Practice Facilities all week. This “Player Instructor” credential cannot be used by managers, agents or family members under any circumstance. The Instructor credential can be obtained during Player Registration onsite and the Player Services office thereafter.

Equipment Conformance Issues

Locker Room

The players will be utilizing the existing Locker Room facility in the Broadmoor Golf Club. A credential checkpoint will be located outside the Locker Room area. Proper credentials will be required in order to gain entry. There will be Locker Room attendants available to assist players and act as a messenger service during the week of the championship. Caddies will not be permitted in Player Hospitality or the Locker Room.

Merchandise

Merchandise for the 2018 U.S. Senior Open Championship will be available in two (2) locations; the Main Merchandise located near the Main Admission Gate and in The Broadmoor Golf Club merchandise shop. Players, their spouses and their immediate family members will be offered a 20% discount on U.S. Senior Open Merchandise Only “Player” and “Player Guest” credentials are entitled to the discount.

Parking

Player Parking (Lot P) will be located on-site at The Broadmoor West and at The Broadmoor Golf Club. Each player will be issued one (1) Lot P decal which will be available in your courtesy car. Please follow the directions to the club provided in your Lexus courtesy car if you are staying off property as other routes may be detoured due to championship traffic patterns.



Player Hospitality

Player Hospitality will be located in the Broadmoor Golf Club near the Locker Room. Breakfast, lunch and afternoon snacks will be served daily, compliments of the USGA. Only players and their guests with the proper credentials may gain access into Player Hospitality. A credential scanning check-point will be located just outside the Player Hospitality area. Only “Player” and “Player Guest” credentials will grant access into this area. An additional area attached to the Locker Room will be available for Player Only Dining.

Player Mail and Package Delivery

All player mail and packages will be delivered to the Locker Room. The Broadmoor has one address for both standard mail and packages. All mail and packages will be thoroughly screened at a postal inspection facility prior to arrival on-site. Please use the following address:

Practice Facility

Players will have access to the practice range and a short game area located in close proximity to the Broadmoor Golf Club. A credential check-point will be located at the entrance to the Practice Facilities and proper credentials will be required in order to gain access. Only a player, his caddie and his instructor will have access to the Practice Facilities.

The Practice Facilities will be open during the following hours:

Practice Rounds

The Broadmoor will be accessible, pending availability, for any player wanting to make an advance trip prior to the U.S. Senior Open Championship. Please contact Robbie Zalneck, Co-Director, U.S. Senior Open, via cell 910.409.0465 for further details.

Players arriving early to the championship will have access to play practice rounds Friday, June 22 through Sunday, June 24 on a first-come-first-served basis. Official championship practice rounds are scheduled to begin on Monday, June 25. Practice round tee times for Sunday-Wednesday can be secured by calling the Player Services Office (908.748.4770) or upon arrival at player registration.

Registration

Player Registration will be conducted in the West Ballroom. Players may register beginning Sunday, June 24 at 8:00 a.m. Registration officially closes at 6:00 p.m. on Tuesday, June 26.

Registration hours are the following:

Monday, June 25 7:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m.

Tuesday, June 26 7:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m.

Players must register in person during the hours listed above, unless they officially notify the USGA. Any player who has not registered on-site or has not notified the USGA by 2:00 p.m. on Tuesday, June 26, is subject to having his spot in the championship replaced by an alternate.

Two-Tee Start

The 2018 U.S. Senior Open will utilize a two-tee start, from the 1st and 10th tees, during the Thursday and Friday championship rounds. In addition, the two-tee start format will be used during the official practice rounds.
