



Internal Revenue Service (IRS) Account Transcript

The '**Account Transcript**' is a single-page document issued by the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) that serves as proof your Federal Tax Return was filed and processed.

Step 1: Sign In to your Online Account

- Go to [IRS Transcript Website](https://www.irs.gov/individuals/get-transcript) (<https://www.irs.gov/individuals/get-transcript>)
- Click on 'Sign into your online account'

i You only need one ID.me account

If you already have an account, don't create a new one. You can use the same ID.me account to sign in to different IRS online services.

The IRS offers a sign-in option with ID.me, which offers access to IRS online services with a secure account that protects your privacy.

ID.me is an account created, maintained, and secured by a technology provider.

If you don't have an ID.me account, you must create a new account.
