

COURTESY CARS / RENTAL VEHICLES

In the U.S. Amateur Host Club agreement, it is a Host Club requirement to provide courtesy cars for the USGA. However, through the USGA's Corporate Partnership with Lexus (established through 2020), the U.S. Amateur now receives the use of 85 courtesy vehicles, eliminating the need for the Host Club to secure cars. Assignment of the Lexus vehicles is per the chart below:

The Host Club may use their allotment of vehicles for course evacuation, transportation or a combination of the two requirements. The vehicle make and model are solely determined by Lexus and special requests may not be granted. The USGA's relationship is with Lexus' corporate office, not through the individual dealerships. So please do not contact the local dealership for additional cars, program ads, donations for the championship, etc. Any special requests regarding the courtesy cars should go through the USGA.

The USGA and the Host Club will need to discuss insurance requirements for the courtesy cars. The Host Club is responsible for all gasoline charges for their allotment of vehicles.

LEXUS VEHICLE SET UP

The Host Club will work with Lexus and the USGA to discuss set up of the Lexus vehicles. Set up will include:

1. Pre-Program six (6) points of interest in the Lexus navigation system. These should include the Host Club, the Stroke Play Co-Host (if applicable), the host hotel(s) and the airport. If space permits, other local points of interest can be saved.
2. Review specific driving directions to the points of interest to make sure the championship preferred routing is shown. If a different route is preferred, written directions and maps should be placed in the cars.
3. Instructions for the use of the vehicle should be printed and placed in the vehicle, listing items such as keyless start, type of fuel, etc.
4. Select local radio stations and save within the pre-set channels.

USGA COURTESY CAR DISTRIBUTION

The Host Club will work with Lexus and the USGA to determine the best place to stage the allotment of courtesy cars prior to the championship for distribution to the USGA attendees. Distribution can be handled at the airport, the club and/or the USGA host hotel, which ever may be suitable for that specific area.

RENTAL CARS / VANS

The USGA can assist with providing rental car and van discounts through our continued working relationship with Avis and Budget Group. The Avis Budget Group will work with the USGA to provide a special rate for players and guests for the U.S. Amateur Championship. Avis can also provide support and preferred pricing for 12 passenger vans if needed for transportation or for on course evacuation vehicles.
