

PLAYER AND RULES OFFICIAL GIFTS

PLAYER GIFT

It is customary for the Host Club to provide a memento from the club to the players in the U.S. Amateur field. The gift is typically given to the player during onsite Player Registration. The Host Club is responsible for all costs and it must be reviewed and approved by the USGA. Host Clubs should take into account that players are traveling, most of them by plane, so be aware of the size and weight of the item that you may choose. Gifts should be no more than \$100 per player and generally range between \$40 and \$60 per player. The Host Club should order 325 gifts to cover all players, any alternates that get in the field and 3 - 5 samples for the USGA.

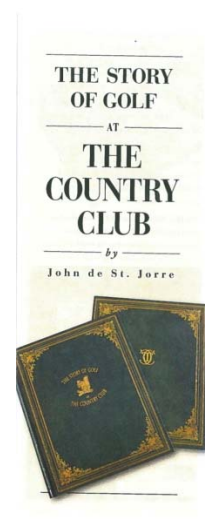

Custom AG Jeans with trophy image, AG Jeans golf shirt, AG tote and U.S. Amateur Poster.



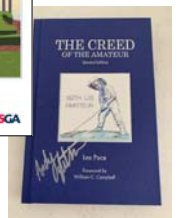
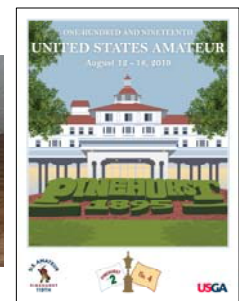
2018 Player Gift

USGA GIFT TO RULES OFFICIALS

Each year a gift will be arranged to be given to the Rules Officials on behalf of the USGA (ordered and paid by the USGA).

HOST CLUB GIFT TO USGA OFFICIALS

Host Clubs may offer a gift to USGA Officials, which includes the USGA Executive Committee, USGA Staff and Rules Officials. This gift is entirely optional for the Host Club. This would always be in addition to the USGA gift to the Rules Officials as described above. If the Host Club decides to give a gift to the USGA Officials, it is recommended to be conscious of the item size and weight as most officials travel by plane to the event and are limited on what can be taken on the plane back with them. The USGA does not recommend shipping gifts. To cover all USGA Officials, 100 gifts will be necessary.
