

RULES COMMITTEE DINNER

The USGA hosts, at its expense, the Rules Committee Dinner on the Monday evening after the 1st round of stroke play concludes. The dinner is to thank the Rules Committee for their time and support of the U.S. Amateur Championship. The USGA will determine all components including location, menu, attendees, etc. and will cover all relevant costs.

Attendees

Approximately 70 individuals attend the Rules Committee Dinner. The USGA Rules Committee and a select few USGA staff members make up the attendance number.

Location

The USGA will select the location of the Rules Committee Dinner in consultation with the Host Club. The Host Club (Match Play Course) is the ideal location of the dinner as most attendees will be assigned to work at that location and can come to the dinner straight from the golf course if necessary. Other possible locations include the host hotel, the Stroke Play Co-Host if applicable, and nearby landmarks.

Attire

The Rules Committee will be instructed to come as you are to the dinner. Country club casual is the preferred language.
