

SCORING TENTS, TEE MARKERS, TEE SIGNS

SCORING TENTS

A local vendor will need to be identified to provide tents (10' x 10'), four (4) of which will be utilized on #9 and #18 putting greens on each course. Each tent will have sidewalls on three sides that can be closed for protection from wind or rain or opened for ventilation. Tents should be built on level ground.

The following list provides a list of items needed at the designated areas:

Starters Area: (1) 6' banquet table – no linens, USGA will supply fitted cloths
1 folding chair
1 garbage bin
1 recycling bin
Food / beverage requirements separate

Scoring Tents: (1) 8' banquet table – no linens, USGA will supply fitted cloths
5 folding chairs
1 large garbage container
1 large recycling container
Food / beverage requirements separate

All tents should be in place by Saturday, if possible, so players can familiarize with the layout during the Championship. The USGA will work with club staff in determining the location of each tent. Once the stroke play portion of the championship has been completed, the tents are no longer needed and will be removed.

TEE MARKERS

The USGA will supply tee markers for the championship. Tee Markers will be drop-shipped prior to the Championship to the USGA's attention. Please hold these with all other USGA shipments. All other tee markers and course fixtures (benches, ball washer, etc.) should be removed by the Host Club.

TEE SIGNS

USGA will have 40 championship tee signs along with hole, yardage and par magnets. The signage vendor will be responsible for the installation of each sign on the corresponding hole. In coordination with an irrigation specialist each sign location will be determined and marked to avoid any issues when installing the posts. Signs should point toward the hole (fairway/green) being played.
