

USGA EQUIPMENT

EQUIPMENT ARRIVALS

The USGA ships quite a bit of equipment ranging in all sizes and weights prior to the championship. The equipment usually begins arriving up to three (3) months prior to the championship and usually comes directly from other championships. The USGA has started to take a concerted effort to cut down on the number of equipment deliveries prior to staff arrival and hope to make one large delivery closer to the Championship dates.

USGA STORAGE

It is helpful for the club to have a designated place set aside, near the USGA Office preferably, to store all equipment until USGA Staff arrives on-site to distribute to designated locations. This eliminates confusion as to where any shipments may have been placed when they are needed during the Championship.

Given the large amount of equipment the required storage space needed is usually around 250-300 square feet. Additional space may be needed dependent on other items which may require storing such as gifts, coolers, or other large volume items.

USGA SHIPPING

All freight costs for this equipment to be delivered to the championship and shipping charges after the championship are paid by the USGA. Packing and re-labeling of all USGA equipment will begin during the last weekend of the championship. All USGA shipping will be taken care of by Monday following the completion of the championship on Sunday.

STROKE PLAY CO-HOST EQUIPMENT

If the championship has a Stroke Play Co-Host, equipment needed for that site will be delivered directly to the Stroke-Play Co-Host. The USGA will handle organizing the shipment once onsite. In turn, the equipment will be organized and shipped out following the completion of stroke play on Wednesday of championship week to decrease the impact on the Co-Host.

HOST CLUB ADDRESS

The Host Club should provide the USGA the preferred shipping address for these deliveries by December of the year prior to championship.
